Amankwakrom Fisheries and Agricultural Technical Institute is situated in the Kwahu Afram Plains North District in the Eastern Region of Ghana. The Institute is situated on a thousand and seventy-one (1071) acre of land. The land has its southern side boundary hemmed by the Volta Lake. The community in which the Institute is located is Amankwakrom, a resettlement community put up by the Volta River Authority (VRA).

The Principal vocation of the community is Farming and Fishing. The Island nature of the district and availability of resources compelled the Government of Ghana at the time to establish the Institute to train and equip the youth with skills in various trade areas including Farming and Fishing.
